student first entered college, not by the student's residential home state. The percentage of Nebraska institutions with Clearinghouse records varied by type of institution. The data coverage rate for Nebraska's four-year public institutions was 100.0%, Nebraska's four-year private nonprofit institutions was 99.9%, and Nebraska's two-year public colleges was 100.0%. First-time enrollment status was established by confirming that a student (1) did not show any postsecondary enrollment record prior to fall 2017 (not counting dual enrollments while still in high school), and (2) did not receive a degree or certificate from any postsecondary institution prior to fall 2017, according to Clearinghouse data unless the award date was before the student turned 18 years old. Since Clearinghouse enrollment data does not include a flag for dual enrollment, students were classified as dual enrollment if their enrollment/degree records prior to fall 2017 were before the student turned 18 years old.
