Introduction

The Supplemental Forms collect enrollment, tuition & fees, and financial aid data from Nebraska's public postsecondary institutions. This information serves as a supplement to IPEDS data, often providing an increased level of detail. Along with the Coordinating Commission's various reports and analyses, the Supplemental Forms serve as the main data source for a number of national surveys, including SHEEO's annual SHEF report. Externally, the Nebraska Legislative Fiscal Office relies on this information for its annual evaluation of the state's public institutions.

The following report contains a portion of the Supplemental Forms data collected from Nebraska's public postsecondary institutions. The rest of the data are available online at the Coordinating Commission's website.

Please note – the Coordinating Commission has run limited validations on these data and assumes no responsibility for errors or omissions. For consistency, the Coordinating Commission has classified financial aid awards according to its interpretation of each category's definition, which may differ from the institutions' classifications.
