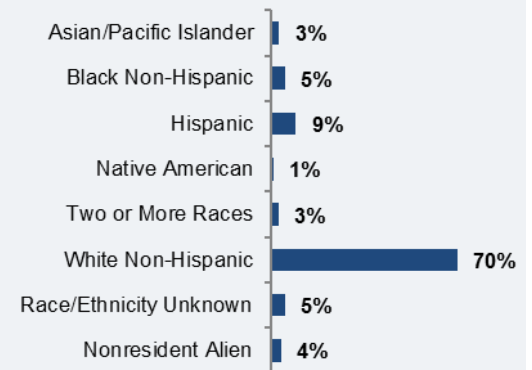
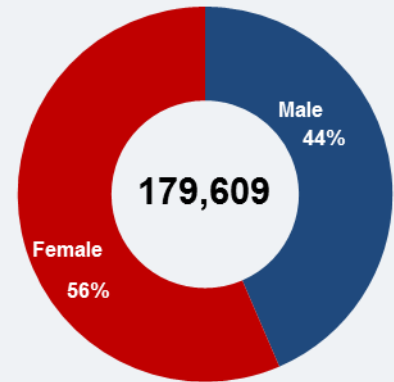

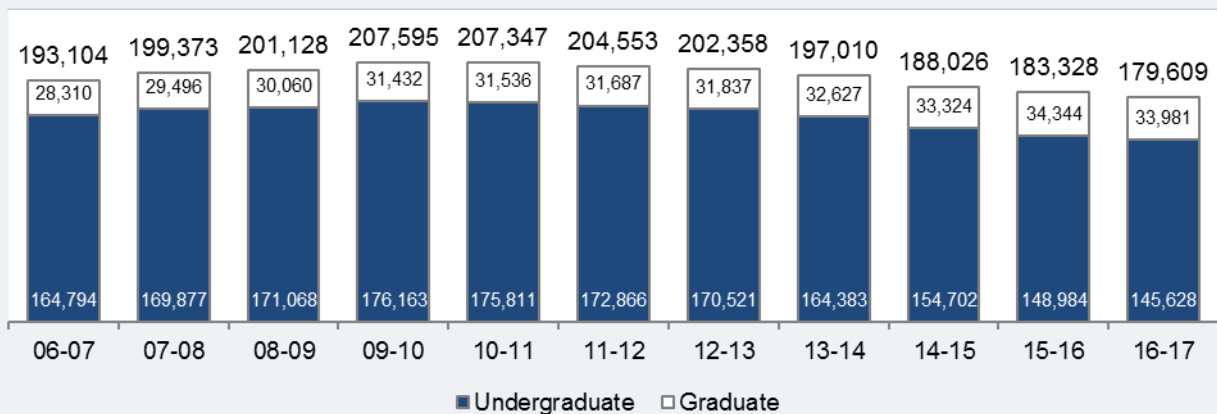

Between 2006-07 and 2016-17, **undergraduate enrollment decreased 11.6%**, while **graduate enrollment increased 20.0%**. Overall, enrollment decreased 7.0%.

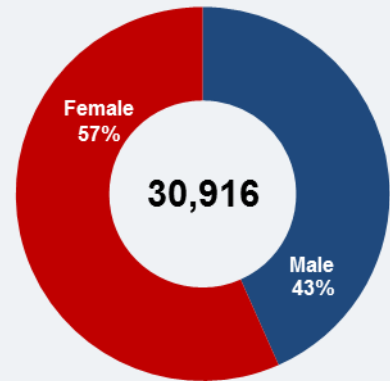


12-month enrollment is the total, unduplicated headcount of students enrolled during the academic year.

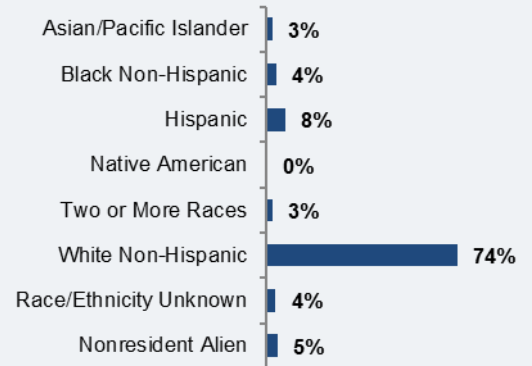
