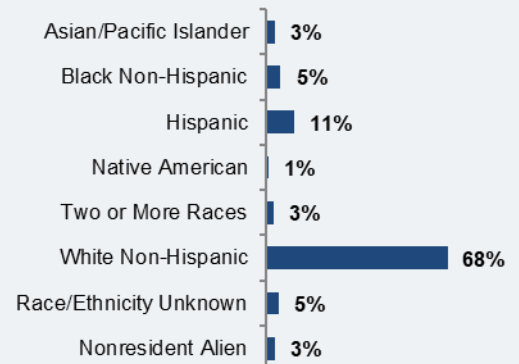
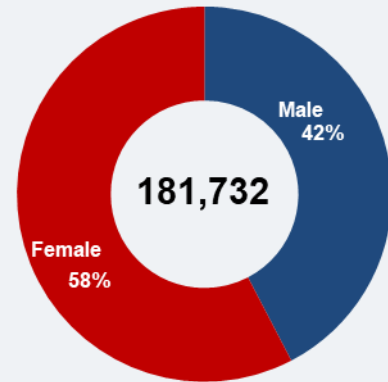


# Nebraska Postsecondary Enrollment and Degrees

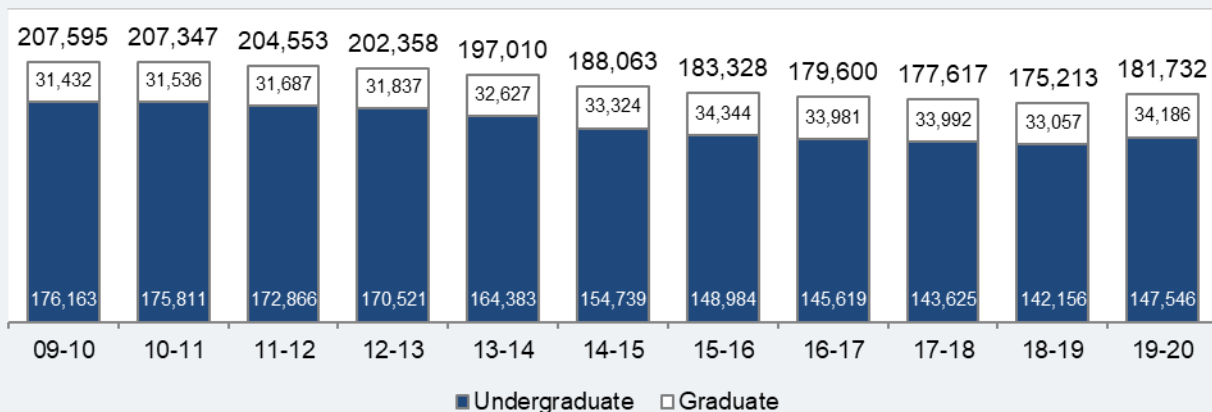

## 12-Month Enrollment Trends

Between 2009-10 and 2019-20, **undergraduate enrollment decreased 16.2%**, while **graduate enrollment increased 8.8%**. Overall, enrollment decreased 12.5%.

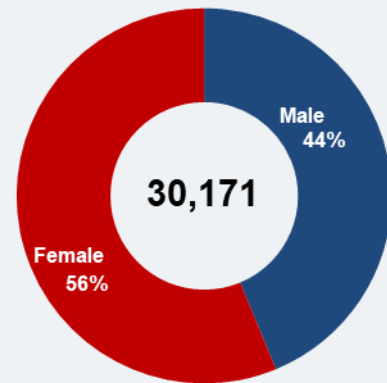


Note. 12-month enrollment is the total, unduplicated headcount of students enrolled during the academic year.

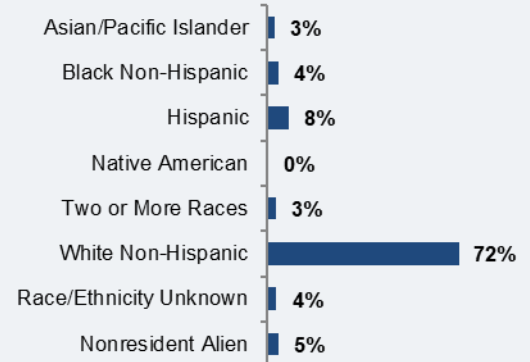
