Fall On-Campus Enrollment

On-campus enrollment comprises the number of students physically attending classes on each institution's campuses during its peak term of enrollment. Students attending multiple campuses are counted in the headcount of each campus where they take classes on site. These figures do not include students taking only online or off-campus courses. FTE is calculated using 15 semester credit hours, 15 quarter credit hours, and 450 contact hours for undergraduate students and 12 for graduate students.

The Community Colleges provide both credit classes and non-credit classes. The state provides funding for all students enrolled in credit courses and provides some funding for non-credit classes depending on the type of non-credit courses. Some examples of non-credit courses that qualify for the state funding (reimbursable) are training classes for Cabela's, Regional West Medical Center, and Rural Public Safety Institute. Other non-credit classes that do not qualify for state funding would be flower arranging or furniture repair.
