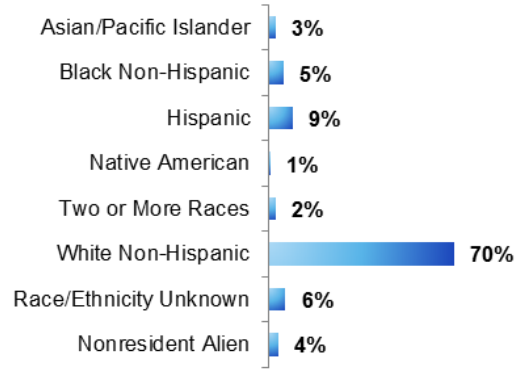
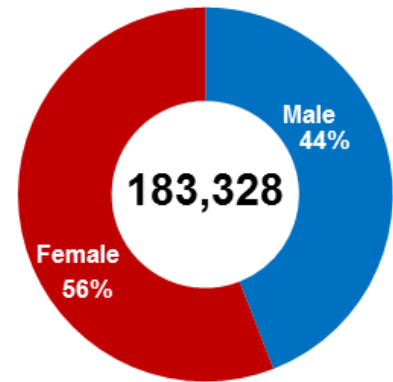

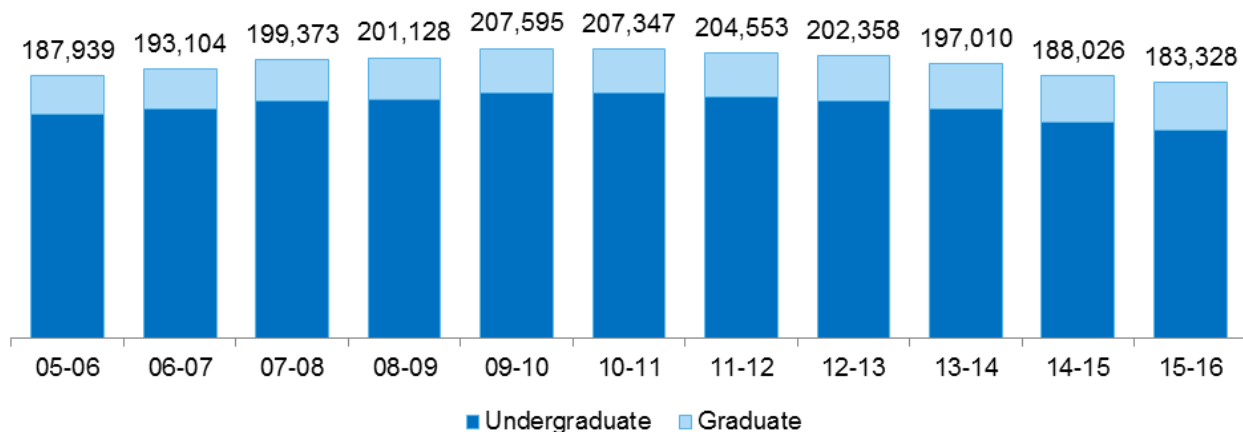

Between 2005-06 and 2015-16, **undergraduate enrollment decreased 7.4%** (from 160,976 to 148,984), while **graduate enrollment increased 27.4%** (from 26,963 to 34,344). Overall, enrollment decreased 2.5%



\* Enrollment is typically calculated in one of two ways — 12-month enrollment or Fall enrollment. Fall enrollment provides a “snapshot” of the total number of students enrolled at an institution on or about October 15 each year. 12-month enrollment is the total, unduplicated headcount of students enrolled during the academic year.

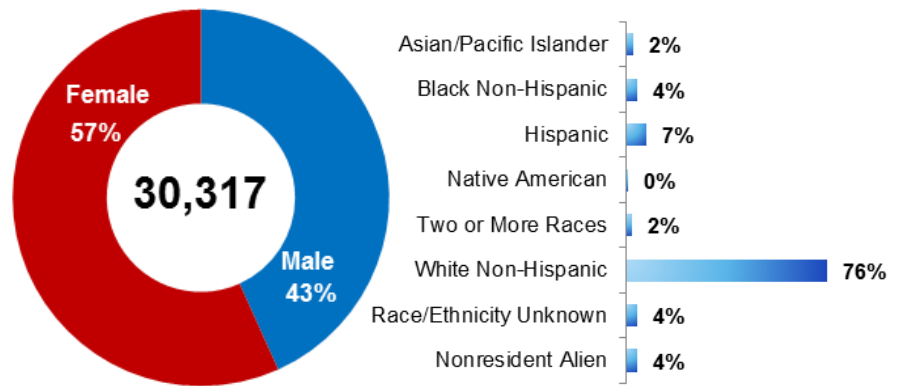
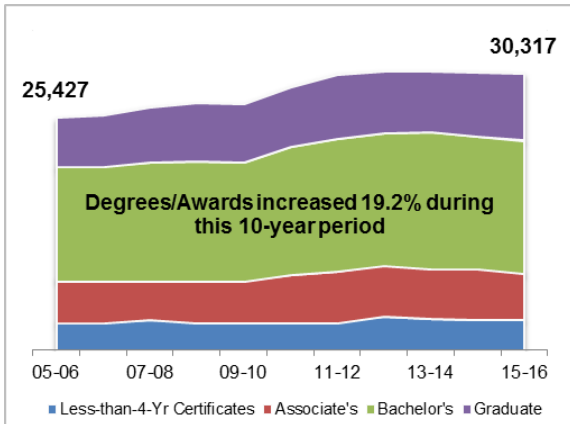
