




Between 2004–05 and 2014–15, **graduate enrollment increased 23.7%** (from 26,446 to 32,716), while **undergraduate enrollment increased 0.6%** (from 153,665 to 154,527). Overall, enrollment increased 4.0%.



\* Enrollment is typically calculated in one of two ways — 12-month enrollment or Fall enrollment. Fall enrollment provides a “snapshot” of the total number of students enrolled at an institution on or about October 15 each year. 12-month enrollment is the total, unduplicated headcount of students enrolled during the academic year.
