## Background

- Coordinating Commission is required by statute to report IPEDS data
- Responsibility is fulfilled through the publication of the Factual Look and other reports, such as the Nebraska Higher Education Progress Report
- Factual Look is generally used by legislative staff, institutional researchers and Commission staff
- Provides a statewide statistical analysis
- Focuses on ten-year trends
- Does not answer "why"


## Background

- Consists of three parts:
- Degrees and Other Awards
- Data presented at August's Commission meeting
- Enrollment
- Faculty and Salaries
- Completed sections of the Factual Look are approved by the Commission's Executive Director after consulting with the Planning and Consumer Information Committee
- Ensures timely dissemination of data
- Factual Look is now primarily an online publication
- Data corresponding to each section are available for download via the Commission's website


## Important Technical Notes

- Adjustments are occasionally made to improve data accuracy. Therefore, it is generally advisable to reference the most recent edition of this report.
- Due to rounding, percentages may not sum to $100.0 \%$ for data summarized in this report.

## Location of Students Enrolled Exclusively in Distance Education Courses (2014)

- Undergraduate
- 72\% of Exclusively Distance Enrollments were Located in Nebraska
- Ranges from $40 \%$ at the independent institutions to $98 \%$ at the forprofit/career schools
- Graduate
- 46\% of Exclusively Distance Enrollments were Located in Nebraska
- Ranges from $38 \%$ at the independent institutions to $100 \%$ at the forprofit/career schools

## Fall Enrollment Compared to 12-Month Enrollment

- Fall enrollment provides a "snapshot" of the total number of students who were enrolled at an institution on October 15 or the institution's official fall reporting date
- 12-month enrollment
- Increased 9.4\% between 2004 and 2013
- Fall enrollment
- Increased 13.8\% between fall 2004 and fall 2013
- In general, both metrics follow similar trends for most sectors/institutions in Nebraska, indicating that either is a valid measure for trend analyses
