Background

- Coordinating Commission is required by statute to report IPEDS data
 - Responsibility is fulfilled through the publication of the Factual Look and other reports, such as the Nebraska Higher Education Progress Report
- *Factual Look* is generally used by legislative staff, institutional researchers, and Commission staff
- Provides a statewide statistical analysis
 - Focuses on 10-year trends
 - Does not answer "why"

Background

- Consists of two parts:
 - Degrees and Other Awards
 - Enrollment
- Executive Director approves sections of the Factual Look as they are completed after consultation with the Planning and Consumer Information Committee
 - Ensures timely dissemination of data
- Factual Look is primarily an online publication
 - Data corresponding to each section are available for download via the Commission's website
 - Data users are able to view degree data via a dashboard on the Commission's website: <u>https://ccpe.nebraska.gov/degrees-and-other-awards-dashboard</u>
 - The Commission also produces a more detailed 6-digit CIP dashboard: <u>https://ccpe.nebraska.gov/degrees-and-other-awardscip-code-dashboard</u>

- For each figure in this presentation, you'll see a graphic like this in the lower left side of the screen. The page number of the report that coincides with the figure is in the magnifying glass.


What's New for 2023



Total Degrees and Other Awards Conferred by Sector



University of Nebraska Total Degrees and Other Awards by College




Nebraska State College System Total Degrees and Other Awards by College

10-Year Change: 13.3%




Nebraska Community Colleges Total Degrees and Other Awards by College

10-Year Change: -4.8%











Completers by Age Group


- While Sections 1 through 5 analyze the number of awards conferred, Section 6 analyzes the number of students who earned awards
 - In Section 6, a student is counted only once per award level
 - Example 1: If a student is awarded two bachelor's degrees...
 - Completions (Sections 1-5): Two bachelor's degrees are counted.
 - Completers (Section 6): The student is counted only once at the bachelor's level.
 - Example 2: If a student is awarded an associate's degree and a bachelor's degree...
 - Completions (Sections 1-5): One associate's degree and one bachelor's degree are counted.
 - Completers (Section 6): The student is counted once at the associate's level and once at the bachelor's level.
 - Therefore, the numbers for Sections 1 through 5 will NOT match the numbers for Section 6
- In Sections 1 through 5, we combine postbaccalaureate certificates with bachelor's degrees and post-master's certificates are combined with master's degrees



However, since IPEDS utilizes different award level groupings for Section 6, the Commission is obligated to group postbaccalaureate and post-master's certificates into one award level category



Completers by Level by Age Group

- Undergraduate completers were most likely to be 24 years or younger, while graduate completers were most likely to be 25-39 years of age
- Majority of completers from the three public sectors were 24 years or younger, while the completers from the nonpublic sector were most likely to be 25-39 years of age



Note. The bachelor's degree category does <u>not</u> include postbaccalaureate certificates. The master's degree category does <u>not</u> include post-master's certificates.

 - Increased 74.6%, from 1,090 to 1,903
 - Then select Associate's
 - Increased 6.1%, from 658 to 698

 - Under tab Completions Graphs, select Central Community College and select Certificate – Less than 1 Year
 - 292 awards at this level for CIP 47 (Mechanic and Repair Technologies/Technicians), which is 22.3% of awards at this level
