Background

- Coordinating Commission is required by statute to report IPEDS data
 - Responsibility is fulfilled through the publication of the Factual Look and other reports, such as the Nebraska Higher Education Progress Report
- Factual Look is generally used by legislative staff, institutional researchers, and Commission staff
- Provides a statewide statistical analysis
 - Focuses on 10-year trends
 - Does not answer "why"

Background

- Consists of two parts:
 - Degrees and Other Awards
 - Enrollment
- Executive Director approves sections of the Factual Look as they are completed after consultation with the Planning and Consumer Information Committee
 - Ensures timely dissemination of data
- Factual Look is primarily an online publication








University of Nebraska Total Degrees and Other Awards by College



10-Year Change: 13.0%




Nebraska Community Colleges Total Degrees and Other Awards by College




Nebraska Nonpublic Institutions Total Degrees and Other Awards by College







Total Degrees and Other Awards Conferred by Level by Gender









Completers by Age Group


SECTION 6

Completers by Age Group

- While Sections 1 through 5 analyze the number of awards conferred,
 Section 6 analyzes the number of students who earned awards
 - In Section 6, a student is counted only once per award level
 - Example 1: If a student is awarded two bachelor's degrees...
 - Completions (Sections 1-5): Two bachelor's degrees are counted.
 - Completers (Section 6): The student is counted only once at the bachelor's level.
 - Example 2: If a student is awarded an associate's degree and a bachelor's degree...
 - Completions (Sections 1-5): One associate's degree and one bachelor's degree are counted.
 - Completers (Section 6): The student is counted once at the associate's level and once at the bachelor's level.
 - Therefore, the numbers for Sections 1 through 5 will NOT match the numbers for Section 6
- In Sections 1 through 5, we combine postbaccalaureate certificates with bachelor's degrees and post-master's certificates are combined with master's degrees
 - However, since IPEDS utilizes different award level groupings for Section 6, the Commission is obligated to group postbaccalaureate and post-master's certificates into one award level category



Completers by Level by Age Group

- Undergraduate completers were most likely to be 24 years or younger, while graduate completers were most likely to be 25-39 years of age
- Majority of completers from the three public sectors were 24 years or younger, while the completers from the nonpublic sector were most likely to be 25-39 years of age



Note. The bachelor's degree category does <u>not</u> include postbaccalaureate certificates. The master's degree category does <u>not</u> include post-master's certificates.

- How much have less-than-four-year certifications changed over the last decade at CCC compared to the other five community colleges?
 - Click on Nebraska Community Colleges, select Keep Only
 - Under tab Degrees and Other Awards, select Less-than-Four-Year Certificates
 - CCC increased 34.1%, from 1,556 to 2,086
 - Then click on Central Community College, select Exclude
 - The other five community colleges decreased 7.2%, from 5,454 to 5,059
 - Northeast increased while the remaining four CCs decreased



- At Central, what is the most common program for lessthan-one-year certificates?
 - Under tab Completions Graphs, select Central Community
 College and select Certificate Less than 1 Year
 - 349 awards at this level for CIP 47 (Mechanic and Repair Technologies/Technicians), which is 23.5% of awards at this level
