# Background

- Coordinating Commission is required by statute to report IPEDS data
  - Responsibility is fulfilled through the publication of the Factual Look and other reports, such as the Nebraska Higher Education Progress Report
- *Factual Look* is generally used by legislative staff, institutional researchers, and Commission staff
- Provides a statewide statistical analysis
  - Focuses on 10-year trends
  - Does not answer "why"

# Background

- Consists of two parts:
  - Degrees and Other Awards
  - Enrollment
- Executive Director approves sections of the Factual Look as they are completed after consultation with the Planning and Consumer Information Committee
  - Ensures timely dissemination of data
- Factual Look is primarily an online publication

- For each figure in this presentation, you'll see a graphic like this in the lower left side of the screen. The page number of the report that coincides with the figure is in the magnifying glass.


## What's New for 2025

  - (Ricketts Great Books was not added to this year's listing because they opened in Fall 2024 and the most recently reported data period goes through June 30, 2024)









#### 10-Year Change: 8.2%









#### **Total Degrees and Other Awards Conferred by Level by Sex**









### **Completers by Age Group**


- While Sections 1 through 5 analyze the number of awards conferred, Section 6 analyzes the number of students who earned awards
  - In Section 6, a student is counted only once per award level
    - Example 1: If a student is awarded two bachelor's degrees...
      - Completions (Sections 1-5): Two bachelor's degrees are counted.
      - Completers (Section 6): The student is counted only once at the bachelor's level.
    - Example 2: If a student is awarded an associate's degree and a bachelor's degree...
      - Completions (Sections 1-5): One associate's degree and one bachelor's degree are counted.
      - Completers (Section 6): The student is counted once at the associate's level and once at the bachelor's level.
  - Therefore, the numbers for Sections 1 through 5 will NOT match the numbers for Section 6
- In Sections 1 through 5, we combine postbaccalaureate certificates with bachelor's degrees and post-master's certificates are combined with master's degrees



### **Completers by Level by Age Group**

- Undergraduate completers were most likely to be 24 years or younger, while graduate completers were most likely to be 25-39 years of age
- Majority of completers from the three public sectors were 24 years or younger, while the completers from the nonpublic sector were most likely to be 25-39 years of age

- How much have less-than-four-year certifications changed over the last decade at Metro and SCC compared to the other four community colleges?
  - Under tab Degrees and Other Awards, click on Nebraska Community Colleges, select Keep Only
  - Select Less-than-Four-Year Certificates
    - Metro increased 280%, from 299 to 1,135
    - SCC increased 218%, from 302 to 960
  - Then click on Metro, select Exclude, and click on SCC, select Exclude
    - The other four community colleges increased 37%, from 1,931 to 2,635

- Western decreased while the remaining three CCs increased

- At Metro, what is the most common program for less-than-four-year certificates?
  - Under tab Completions Graphs, select Metropolitan Community College and unselect Associate's
    - Out of 1,135 less-than-four-year awards at Metro for AY23-24, 500 awards were conferred at this level for CIP 47 (Mechanic and Repair Technologies/Technicians), which is 44.1% of awards at this level
