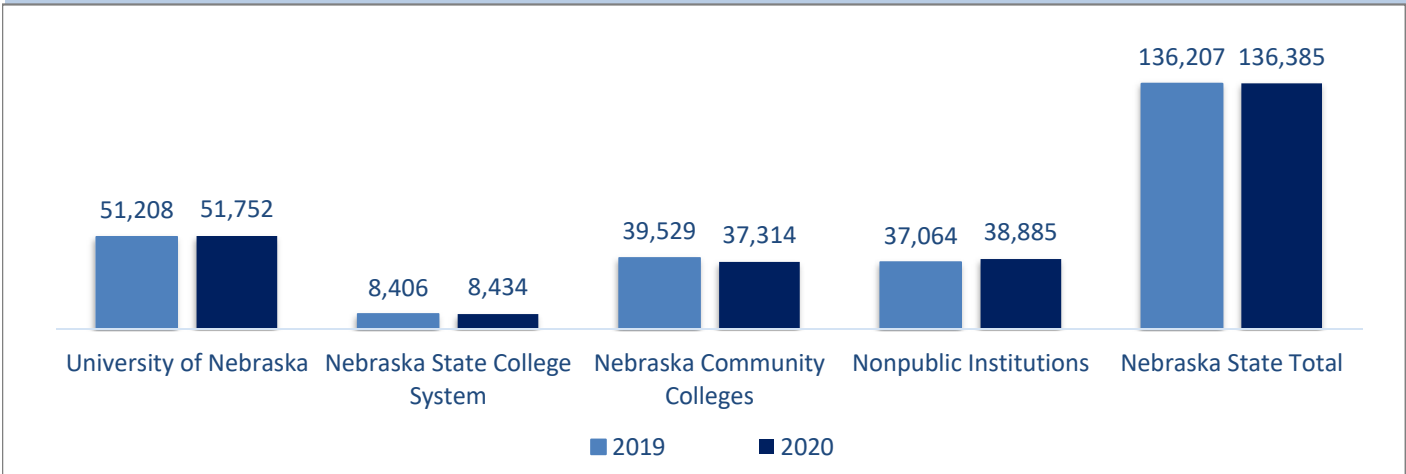


Nebraska's Postsecondary Fall 2020 Enrollments (Preliminary)

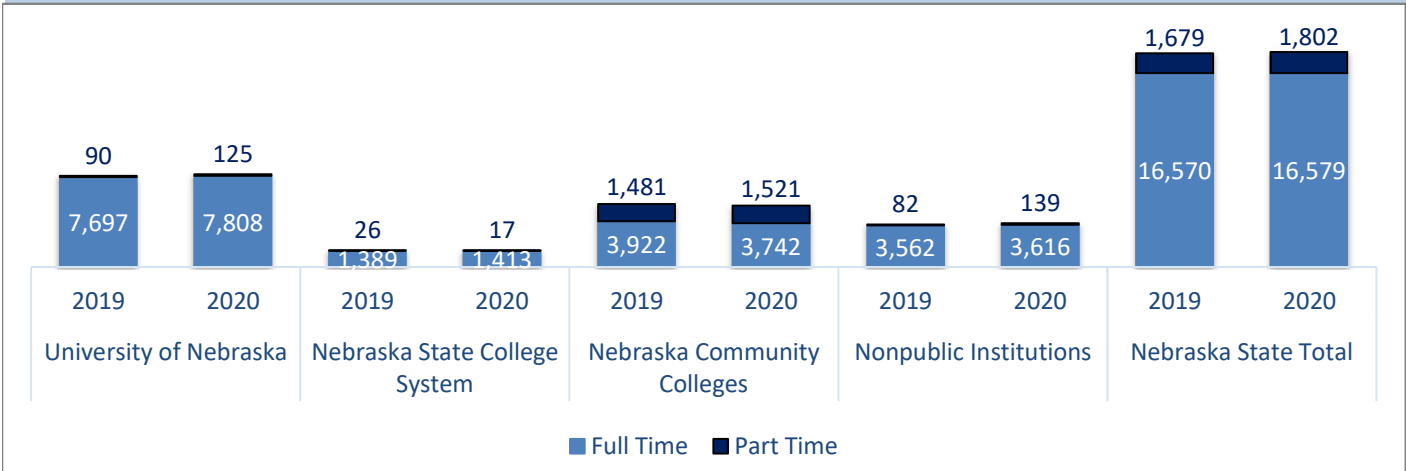


Total Fall Enrollment

Note. Part-time first-time freshmen increased 7.3% while full-time first-time freshmen increased 0.1%. Overall, first-time freshmen increased 0.7%.
