

Nebraska's Postsecondary Fall 2021 Enrollments (Preliminary)





Note. The following changes occurred between fall 2019 and fall 2021: University of Nebraska decreased 2.2%; Nebraska State College System increased 3.8%; community colleges decreased 2.6%; nonpublic institutions decreased 0.8%. Overall, fall enrollment decreased 1.6%.



Note. Since 2019, part-time first-time freshmen increased 5.5% while full-time first-time freshmen decreased 1.0%. Overall, first-time freshmen decreased 0.4%.

Note. Prior to fall 2020, UNMC had been incorrectly including House Officers (residents and fellows) in enrollment counts (approximately 600 per year). Concordia's graduate headcount experienced a one-time enrollment spike due to being a teach-out institution for a closed university in Portland, Oregon. Graduate enrollments increased from 477 in 2019 to 1,065 in 2020.
